

## Welcome to the Trac Open Source Project.


Trac is an enhanced wiki and issue tracking system for software development projects. Trac uses a minimalistic approach to web-based software project management. Our mission is to help developers write great software while staying out of the way. Trac should impose as little as possible on a team's established development process and policies.

It provides an interface to [Subversion](#) and [Git](#) (or other [version control systems](#)), an integrated Wiki and convenient reporting facilities.

Trac allows [wiki markup](#) in issue descriptions and commit messages, creating links and seamless references between bugs, tasks, changesets, files and wiki pages. A [timeline](#) shows all current and past project events in order, making the acquisition of an overview of the project and tracking progress very easy. The [roadmap](#) shows the road ahead, listing the upcoming milestones.
